A WORD FROM THE LEAD PASTOR

2023 was a very interesting year for Foothills Christian Church.

We started the year off with a bang when we introduced the theme for the year: the kingdom of God. We focused on how the gospel message of Jesus Christ was dominated by this idea of the kingdom. Our goal was that everyone who had contact with Foothills Christian Church understood that when Jesus invites them to know him and walk with him, he is inviting them into his kingdom.

We really dug into the New Testament in order to understand the significance of the kingdom of Jesus. One of my favorite parts was our 12 week series on the parables. It really gave a clear understanding of the nature of his kingdom. As I look back on how this theme for the year has affected us as a community of faith, I would say it was a year of transition.

First, it was the year where we finally put Covid 100% behind us and moved forward into new season of ministry. It was a time where we had to shake off the Covid hangover that affected the way we thought, the methods we used, and our strategies for ministry that we developed during the Covid years. This is why we started a relationship with Intentional Churches. You can read their book here if you like. The goal was to develop a new passion, new strategy, based on the unchanging and timeless truth of Jesus Christ and his kingdom.

The result was a clarification of the mission of Jesus Christ in Matthew 28:18 - 20. Where he says, "18 And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. 19Go, therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to follow all that I commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

2023 was a year where we focused on the second part of his great commission, make disciples. We added more discipleship opportunities, more disciplers, and more tools and resources for people involved in discipleship ship relationships.



Now in the coming year we want to build on everything we accomplished in 2023 in order to focus on the first part of that great commission: go.

I hope you find all the facts, figures and stories in the following report encouraging, hopeful, and inspiring. I hope you see that Jesus is king and he is still the center of Foothills Christian Church. He is doing great things through us and in us. STUDENT MINISTRY

The mission of the Youth Ministry here at Foothills is to "help students know and follow Jesus Christ". Over the past year we have seen several students give their lives to Jesus, others have made re-commitments to make Jesus a priority in their lives, and still others have heard the Gospel message for the first time. In the last year we had an average of 90 students each month between our 3 youth gatherings (Sunday group, HS youth group, and MS youth group). Weekly, students hear the Gospel message and of the forgiveness and grace we have through faith in Christ. We continue to pray that God will bring fruit from these efforts.

2023 was our first year to offer our High School Road Trip. We took 20 students and 4 leaders for an experience they will not soon forget. Part of this trip was attending a youth conference in BigFork, MT put on by Levi Lusko's church (Fresh Life Church). There were powerful moments of growth from the messages given, through times of worship and in prayer as a group. This trip brought our students to a new level of faith and commitment to Jesus as well as strengthening the bond between one another.

The last 2 quarters of the year Foothills Students have gone through the books of Luke, Acts, Galatians, Ephesians, Titus and James. Each week they have been encouraged to read the chapter(s) being studied at Youth Group and come ready for discussion. It has been a great motivator to get students into God's Word regularly outside of youth times.







GUEST EXPERIENCE & WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP TEAM

SMALL GROUPS MINISTRY

The Small Group Ministry of Foothills has been holding steady over the year. With many small groups taking a break for summer they are now back in action. Currently we have 30 small groups covering different categories like men's, women's, activity, and co-ed Bible studies.

We also launched our 1st Steps at Foothills class which acts as a gateway for seekers and new believers to find themselves in a small group. With this class we hope to see more people finding their way to Jesus and getting involved in the life of the Church.

A couple of the new groups that started this year include: a young adult group that meets weekly for relational growth and encouragement to walk daily in their faith and, as well as a women's Adventure Group geared toward attracting new and unconnected women into relationships with other women within the body. This group has the purpose of getting these women connected into a small group or a discipleship relationship.

We have also charted out a plan to bring adult classes to Foothills this coming year. Russ Guenther will be teaching several classes covering topics on "The Nature of God", "Hermeneutics", "Christianity and the Christian Life", and "Essentials of the Faith". We hope these classes will bring further understanding of who God is, how to understand His Word, and what it looks like to live in obedience to Him



Foothills Production and Media is dedicated to crafting an atmosphere where people experience Jesus. Out mission is not just about production; it's about connection - connection souls to Jesus through excellence, creativity and unwavering commitment to His message.

This year we installed new lighting in the auditorium, installed amazing high resolution modular LED screens that have already been used in 5 different configurations to help communicate the gospel in creative ways. We upgraded our microphones and audio systems, produced 5 different podcasts with over 150 episodes of content to help people grow in their faith. We began rebranding our social media and online presence which will continue into 2024 to better reach "the One". We helped produce a valley wide kids event in "True Girl", two valley-wide women's event with Nights of Unity, and were able to help tell the stories of ministries through "Did You Know". We also hosted live discussion groups online to help better connect our online congregation to our on-campus congregation. On top of all this, we had amazing Easter and Christmas services that impacted many lives and led many to baptism or deeper faith. In 2024 we want to push ourselves to share the gospel in even more ways with new technology, new story telling and new creative ideas.

WORSHIP

Worship at Foothills is gaining momentum in several areas with the hiring of our new worship pastor, Dylan Cochran. Over the last couple of months, we have seen consistent worship being led from our stage involving veterans, "coming back", and new musicians/vocalists. Throughout the year some highlights were our Good Friday services which packed the brand new Revive Church building with 5 different churches participating. We had an transformational Easter worship set, and powerful steps in teaching our congregation authentic worship throughout the summer.

Last 90 days:

- 1. Team engagement. 2 team members have started to serve again with one new staff/pastoral role filled.
- 2. Worship team devotions and prayer time have been consistent and spirit-led.
- 3. 2 people have inquired about auditioning.
- 4. Have had 3 experienced musicians step in and consider serving here regularly.
- 5. Several leader "discipleship" moments.
- 6. Christmas Eve services involved MANY musicians, and tech team members to complete a very successful service involving worship, communion, a message, and performance pieces that engaged the church at a whole new level. Higher expectations and more rehearsals were set and accomplished.
- 7. Sunday services have been tweaked to allow for better transitions and time to grow in our prayer and spirit-led worship times with an emphasis on "teaching" worship.

2024 will involve 1-2 vision nights. More work on recruiting musicians and vocalists with a huge continued focus on team unity, and spiritual/musical/relational growth as well as teaching and growing our congregation to become better worshipers.





MISSIONS

In 2023 FH continued to faithfully support, with prayer and financial donations, the school and orphanage in India, the orphanage and farm in Haiti, as well as Casa de Fe, the children's home in Ecuador. FH also financially supports a Cru missionary who works with BSU students, inviting and discipling college students to follow Christ.
