INTRODUCTION

In 1 Corinthians 13:11, the Apostle Paul write: "When I was a child, I used to speak like a child, think like a child, reason like a child; when I became a man, I did away with childish things."

This series is one of the most challenging series we have ever done. In my 38 years of full-time ministry, I have never seen a church do a series like this, and I have never attempted a series like this.

We are doing this series because I want you to develop **mental strength**. I want you to be strong, mature, solid.

Here's the challenge: Most of us have been trained to think in a way that makes us **weak**. It undermines our confidence. Therefore, we must be trained to think in a new way.

The path to mental strength, intellectual confidence, and security in the direction of your life is all about your **foundation**.

Step 1: Find and set your foundational intellectual stones

1 Corinthians 14:20 "Brothers and sisters, do not be children in your thinking; yet in evil be infants, but in your thinking be mature."

Set **foundation stones** that are intellectually unassailable.

That's why these are called **proofs**. In logic, a **proof** is like a scientific fact

• In addition to the archeological evidence, the extent literature evidence, the historical evidence, this is rational evidence -- philosophical evidence that proves there is a God

Now why is it so important to be able to prove there is a God?

- It is the most important question you will ever ask -- both sides agree this is the most important question
- Your position on whether there is a God or not is the most important belief in your life -- it directs the nature of all your other beliefs

Let's get started...

#1 - The Moral Argument

- Without God there are no objective morals or duties
- However, there ARE objective morals and duties
- Therefore, there is a God

Principle #1: Each premise stands alone

You have to affirm or refute one premise at a time. This strengthens the conclusion

Principle #2: The Conclusion is necessary or required

- If Premise 1 is true and irrefutable, and if premise 2 is true and irrefutable, then you have to abide by the Conclusion
- If you reject the Conclusion while accepting the truth of the claims, then you are an irrational person, a science denier

The power of this proof

1. It is true

- This proof points out 2 critical facts in human existence
 - First, that all human beings are moral beings. The specifics of morality may be different, but the fact that morality is a part of human nature is undeniable
 - o Second, every human being determines there are good morals and bad morals
- If there is no objective standard, people with the most power get to decide what they want to be right and wrong

2. It appeals to GenZ

- Younger people accept there are objective morals and duties -- things that are wrong no
 matter what. They understand that if you remove the foundation for objective morality, then
 you can make up any morality you want
- Young adults seem to recognize that if there is no objective morality, then there is no basis for justice

3. It eradicates nihilism

 The biggest challenge for those who advocate for no objective morals or duties is the conclusion that if morality is subjective, then there is no meaning in life

4. Most importantly, it gives moral clarity

- Moral clarity is required in order for societies to form
- No society has ever formed, developed, or thrived on the basis of no moral clarity
