As we turn the page, there so much hope. We are preparing to celebrate our 100th year as a church, a powerful reminder that Foothills has been and still is a beacon of faith, resilience, and transformation for generations. This past year, we stepped boldly into difficult conversations through our Weeds in My Garden series on mental health, reminding us that the church is called to be a place of healing. Our Food Pantry continued to be the hands and feet of Jesus, feeding hundreds of people, meeting physical and spiritual needs, and showing Christ's love in action. Through the generosity of of the Christ Birthday offering we replaced 600 of our auditorium chairs to brand new black comfortable chairs. Our adult, student and children's ministries have led 50 people to declare Christ as Lord through baptism.

As we step into 2025, we are not just maintaining—we are moving forward. With the guidance of Trent Renner and our partnership with IPM, we are prayerfully searching for our next lead pastor—the person who will help shape the next chapter of our story. New programs are being developed to strengthen families, grow disciples, and equip our church to engage the world around us. We are refining our mission and strategy to become a church that not only gathers but goes—reaching beyond our walls to share the gospel boldly. As Isaiah 43:19 reminds us, "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland." God is leading us forward, and we will follow Him with faith.



Finally, I want to say thank you. To our incredible staff, volunteers, elders and every person who has remained faithful to this church, thank you for choosing to press forward in faith rather than retreat in fear. Your commitment and prayers are the foundation of what God is building here. CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

FH Kids exists to coach and support parents in raising fully devoted disciples of Jesus Christ. This past year, we were incredibly blessed to have Kim Cross serve as our Interim Children's Ministry Director, bringing her heart and leadership to our families before recently retiring. We also celebrate her recent marriage to David Kodanko and honor the lasting impact she has made on our ministry. Currently, FH Kids serves children, from 3 months old through 5th grade, providing engaging, Christ-centered environments where kids learn about God's love in a fun and meaningful way. We continued our three-year chronological journey through the Bible with The Gospel Project curriculum, helping children build a firm biblical foundation that will last a lifetime.

Beyond Sundays, FH Kids offered exciting opportunities for families to connect and grow in faith. Vacation Bible School welcomed 102 children, filling our church with energy, worship, and deep engagement with the gospel. Our Family Beach Day created space for families to enjoy time together, while our Foothills MomCo equipped parents with encouragement and biblical resources led by some amazing women in our congregation. We believe that children's ministry isn't just for kids—it's for the entire family. Every child is a story yet to be told, and we are committed to walking alongside parents in shaping that story for God's glory.



As we look to the future, Pastor Steve will be overseeing both Children's and Student Ministry as our Family Pastor, providing leadership and vision for the next season of growth. We are actively seeking a Children's Ministry Coordinator to further strengthen this ministry, and in the meantime, we want to give a special thank you to Miseda Saeland, who has been doing an incredible job in keeping FH Kids running smoothly. Her dedication and heart for children's discipleship have been a gift to our church.

We also want to invite parents to take an active role in this ministry. In the coming years, we are excited to incorporate new programs designed specifically for moms and dads, focusing on strengthening parent-child relationships, personal spiritual growth, and marriages. Raising children in faith is a journey, and we want to support parents every step of the way. We can't wait to see how God continues to bless FH Kids as we invest in the next generation of Christ-followers together!







STUDENT MINISTRY

Foothills Student Ministry exists to help students know and follow Jesus Christ, equipping them to grow in their faith and build lasting relationships within a Christ-centered community. In 2024, we averaged 139 unique students each month across our three gatherings—Sunday group, High School youth group, and Middle School youth group. These spaces provided students with a place to explore their faith, ask big questions, and develop a deeper relationship with Jesus in a supportive and engaging environment.

This past year, 33 Middle Schoolers attended camp, and 20 High Schoolers embarked on the HS Road Trip, both of which were deeply rooted in God's Word, worship, and life-changing experiences. These trips created moments of transformation, allowing students to step away from their daily routines and encounter God in fresh and powerful ways.

Throughout the year, our midweek gatherings walked through 1 & 2 Samuel, several Minor Prophets, the Gospel of Mark, and the Book of Acts, helping students see the bigger story of God's work in the world. As we look ahead, we are excited to continue fostering an environment where students are challenged to live out their faith, grow in biblical understanding, and develop a lifelong love for Jesus.







SMALL GROUPS & ADULT MINISTRY

Small Groups at Foothills are where life-changing relationships are formed, faith deepens, and community thrives. This past year, we had 22 active small groups, covering a wide range of interests, including men's and women's groups, activity-based gatherings, and co-ed Bible studies. These groups provide a space where people can grow in their relationship with Christ while building strong, supportive connections with others in the church.

A major milestone this year was the launch of a **Rooted pilot program**, with three groups plus staff engaging in this transformational study. Rooted is designed to be more than just a study—it's a pathway to deeper discipleship and a launching point for **new small groups forming in the fall**. Looking ahead, we are also preparing for a **new approach in Spring and Fall 2025**, where all church-sponsored small groups will align with **sermon-based discussions**. This shift will bring greater unity across the church and make it **even easier for new members to find and join a group**.

In addition to small groups, we introduced **Pour Over with the Pastor**, a welcoming class designed to **help newcomers get connected to Foothills**, ask questions, and learn more about our church family. For those newer to faith, this year we will also launch the **Essentials Class**, which provides a strong foundation in **who Jesus is and the authenticity of the Bible**. These new opportunities, along with our growing small group community, are helping more people take their next steps with Christ and with Foothills!

FOOTHILLS FOOD PANTRY & CLOTHING CLOSET



MEDIA & PRODUCTION

The Media & Production Ministry played a crucial role in sharing the gospel, enhancing worship experiences, and fostering collaboration within our church and beyond. This year, we were blessed to host three powerful Christmas and Easter services, create an incredible multi-church collaboration for the Weeds in My Garden series, and assist in the Nights of Unity conference and worship night, bringing women together in worship and unity. Our video studio became a powerful tool for ministry, allowing us to share the gospel in new and impactful ways, while creative projects helped communicate biblical truth in fresh, engaging formats.

A significant focus this year was on **improving the visitor experience** through **wayfinding upgrades and design aesthetics** throughout the church. These updates were designed to **help new visitors navigate the space more easily, feel comfortable, and confidently engage in worship and community.** It also included a collaboration in designing a new **Connection Point Booth** which has seen massive growth in connecting new guest and existing members to new depths of spiritual growth

Looking ahead, we are committed to pursuing excellence in all areas of media and production. Plans are underway to update our website to better reach those seeking Christ in our community. Additionally, we are excited to support other churches in the valley by helping them grow in their ability to share the gospel through media, upgrading technology, and expanding creative capabilities. As we continue innovating, we are seeking new ways to enhance our worship services, develop outreach events, and use media to impact lives for Christ. We look forward to another year of creativity, growth, and gospel-centered storytelling!

WORSHIP

Worship at Foothills has remained a powerful and foundational part of our church, even through seasons of transition. This year, we said goodbye to Pastor Dylan Cochran, who moved on to Refresh Church, and we welcomed Ashlee Flynt as our new Worship Director. Ashlee has been a steady rock in our worship ministry for the last five years, providing strong leadership through constantly changing seasons. Even amid personal challenges, including a very scary couple of months while her husband Nick was in the hospital, Ashlee's unwavering commitment and heart for worship have remained a blessing to our church. We also want to express our deep gratitude for our incredible team of musicians and vocalists, who have been rock-solid through transitions and continue to lead our congregation in heartfelt, Christ-centered worship.

Throughout the past year, we experienced transformational worship moments like the Women's Worship Night, from powerful Easter services to deeply engaging Christmas Eve worship, which involved many musicians, tech team members, and creative elements that took our services to a new level. Worship team devotions and prayer times have remained consistent, fostering spiritual depth among our team. We have also seen new musicians step forward, several inquiries about auditions, and a deepened focus on prayer and spirit-led worship during Sunday services.

Looking ahead, we are excited for more growth in our congregation's ability to worship both individually and together. We will continue to focus on recruiting and developing musicians and vocalists, strengthening team unity and discipleship, and creating vision nights to inspire our worship culture. Above all, we are seeking whatever God has planned next for worship at Foothills, trusting Him to lead us into a deeper, more powerful expression of praise as a church family.







MISSIONS

Missions at Foothills continues to be a vital expression of our faith as we pray for, support, and partner with ministries both locally and globally. In 2024, we remained committed to supporting the school and orphanage in India, the orphanage and farm in Haiti, and Casa de Fe, the children's home in Ecuador. We also continued our partnership with Foster and Heart, helping keep foster siblings together, and provided financial support for a Cru Missionary discipling students at Boise State University. One of the most exciting moments this year was celebrating a family from our congregation adopting a child from Casa de Fe, a beautiful testament to the impact of our mission partnerships. Additionally, we had a record-breaking fundraising year at our annual silent auction, allowing us to further support these incredible ministries.

Looking ahead, we want to increase opportunities for our congregation to engage in missions firsthand, offering more chances to serve both locally and globally. We plan to enhance monthly communication about our current missionaries through updates on the website, stage announcements, and new in-building displays that highlight how Foothills is making a difference. Locally, we are expanding our partnerships with organizations that serve those in need, providing more hands-on serve opportunities for our church family. Continuing this year will be the guest connection card program that contributes to local non-profits, ensuring that every new visitor helps support a ministry that is being the hands and feet of Jesus. One of the greatest blessings at Foothills is our partnership with The Ambrose School, which provides Pre-K through 8th grade education right here on our campus.
