Week of 9/14/2025

Central Theme: Great stories, Great Habits, and Great Relationships create Great Community.

ICE BREAKER: 1. Brainstorm 'things' that create community and tribe loyalty. What is your favorite one? (sports, politics, hobbies, etc) 2. Other than Church, where else have you felt strong community and inclusion?

1. Does anyone have a story about being invited into an existing community, and how did it impact you? Do you agree or disagree that the most powerful gangs and cults exploit loneliness and provide community? Discuss.
2. There were 10 community qualities mentioned this weekend. Can we list them all right now? (*Frequency, Authenticity, Mutuality, Courtesy, Sympathy, Humility, Honesty, Mercy, Confidentiality, and Unity.*)
3. Using your phone or a piece of paper, each individual should write the 10 qualities and then rate themselves 1 - 10 regarding how they are doing with each one. (Share your worst and best with the group, and did this practice impact you? If so, how?)
4. Read **John 17:1-26**. Be willing to interrupt as we read if you have a thought, a question, or a point that you could make. (Use this reading to stimulate spiritual discussion.) Are we living the 10 community qualities?
5. Repeating last week, Read **Acts 2:42-47**.

Now What? Idahoans are “connected” more than ever via social media, but are also lonelier than ever. Discuss what the difference is between connection and community. Commit to identifying and serving disconnected, lonely, and hurting people, and then invite them into the FH community!

Prayer requests. We love to pray for all types of situations (sickness, hospitalization, tough times, etc.). Let's also pray for those disconnected from God and for the courage to invite them into community.

(Prayer Wednesdays 1:16 PM, 2-year Bible reading plan, Serve once a month, Join a FH Life Group, Invite one person a quarter to attend Church, Give financially above and beyond regular tithes and offerings.) These things help build an unshakable community amongst us.
