Demon Possession, Oppression, or Distraction

A person who won't intentionally surrender to God will unintentionally surrender to the world

There is demon <u>possession</u> and demon <u>oppression</u> but we must realize there is also <u>demon</u> <u>distraction</u>.

For many of you, the things we've talked about the last 3 weeks have not been your experience with the spiritual realm. You are not alone, but it would be naive to think you have not been affected by it or influenced by it.

Luke 11:23 (NLT) – "Anyone who isn't with me opposes me, and anyone who isn't working with me is actually working against me."

- I believe this passage is saying, "anything that does not draw us closer to God is slowly drawing us away from Him." There is no NEUTRAL.
- When Jesus says this... I think we can also say that "anything" that isn't with Him opposes Him

The devil doesn't have to destroy you if he can distract you

- Not all people will face or see demon possession, but <u>everyone</u> will have demon distraction
- Demon distraction does not come with erratic behavior

What is being used to distract you?

Luke 11:24-26 (NLT) – "When an evil spirit leaves a person, it goes into the desert, searching for rest. But when it finds none, it says, 'I will return to the person I came from.' 25 So it returns and finds that its former home is all swept and in order. 26 Then the spirit finds seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they all enter the person and live there. And so that person is worse off than before."

- If you cast one out, then replace it with something, you will find yourself back in the same situation
- Demon possession or demon distraction -- we can use the same principle

How do we keep ourselves from the distractions that lead us away from Jesus?

1. Change your focus

- Colossians 3:2-3 "Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth. 3For you died to this life, and your real life is hidden with Christ in God."
- **Philippians 4:8** "And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise."



• **2 Corinthians 10:5** "We destroy every proud obstacle that keeps people from knowing God. We capture their rebellious thoughts and teach them to obey Christ."

2. Armor up

• Ephesians 6:10-18 "A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. 12For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places. 13Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. 14Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness. 15For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. 16In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. 17Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. 18Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere."

3. Surrender your life to the Holy Spirit

- The Holy Spirit is given to each believer upon accepting Jesus as Lord and Savior
 Ephesians 1:13b "And when you believed in Christ, he identified you as his own by giving you the Holy Spirit, whom he promised long ago."
- Surrender yourself to be used/led by God in any situation
 - Money
 - Parenting
 - o Music
 - o Fear
 - Relationships
 - My things

CENTRAL THEME: A person who won't intentionally surrender to God will unintentionally surrender to the world.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What are some of those things in life that seem "neutral" when it comes to faith but can actually become distractions? Get creative in thinking how Satan/demons can use these things against us... or maybe talk about how they are already using it against us.
- 2. How can you practically keep those things from drawing you away from God and instead use them to grow your faith or the Kingdom?
- 3. What areas of your life have you given the Holy Spirit control (surrendered to God)? Be specific. How has He provided for/blessed you in that surrender (e.g., He led you into spiritual conversations with a stranger; you were used by God to bless someone)?

Read 2 Corinthians 10:5 (NLT)

"We destroy every proud obstacle that keeps people from knowing God. We capture their rebellious thoughts and teach them to obey Christ."

- 1. How do we take things captive for Christ?
- 2. What are some areas that you have intentionally NOT surrendered to God that have unintentionally been surrendered to the world? How can you surrender those areas to God? What would that look like?

PRAY

- Surrender to God and ask Him to take control so that distractions do not become footholds for Satan
- If there are already footholds or strongholds in your life, pray and surrender them to God and ask the Holy Spirit to break the hold so that you may glorify Christ with those areas of your life.

Now What?

Remember: You can do all things through Christ who gives you strength. Fear not. Be bold and courageous.
