"Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise! Give thanks to him; bless his name!"
Psalms 100:4 (ESV)

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS

Week of 11/16/2025 - "ROOMS of Gratitude"

CENTRAL THEME: Choose to think, feel and act in accordance with the Bible's truth about Gratitude.

PRIMER | HEY GUYS! Josh here. 1st up, thanks a ton for this incredible past weekend—we're so grateful that Jesus asked us to join Him in His Kingdom work already underway in Boise! Ok, ready?! Here we go!

Just this week, I walked into a room with a handful of veteran teachers & I could almost see their thought bubbles floating over their heads—everyone was grouchy & grumbling about something. But then, one person cut through their grouchiness with just one good thing & you could feel the room change. Ever experienced that?!

We've all walked into rooms where people were grumbling quietly or maybe not so quietly. Perhaps you've been tempted to join in, or maybe you've resisted, but one thing we can all find common ground on is that most of us are drawn more to grateful people than to grumps, right?! But... what if... grumpy people are just carrying the same brokenness that we once held? What if grumpy folks have the same hurts that God has already healed inside you? What if God has you right where He wants you?

ICEBREAKER:

- 1. What is one thing you are grateful for right now & the last thing that made you grumpy?!
- 2. Who is someone that would make it on your 'thank you note' list who has impacted you spiritually to be more like Jesus?
- 3. Who is someone in your relational orbit where you live, work, learn, shop, or play that's more grumpy than grateful that we can pray for by name right now?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Becoming Doers of the Word: Read Colossians 3:15-17 together as a group in 2 translations.

- 1. What does it look like in your life to "let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts?" (v15)
- 2. With constant bombardment from messaging & marketing, what are practical ways we can "let the message of Christ dwell among us richly" as a community & personally? (v16)
- 3. How can practicing "giving thanks" change our heart's postures to be more like Jesus? (v17)

Live It Out | Memorizing God's Word

Live It Out | Action plan
