
TODAY'S MESSAGE (#4): The Use of the Book of “Acts of the Holy Spirit”

1. The Epistles are to Christians
2. Describes the Gospel addressed to non-Christians
3. Where we find Evangelism models
4. Never use commands given to people ALREADY Christian on how to become Christian
5. Two kinds of people addressed in the New Testament
 - A. Not in Christ
 - B. Already in Christ (SEE HANDOUT)

BIBLE FACTS

- **Old Testament = old covenant – 39 Books**
 - Genesis to Malachi
 - Documents of History, Poetry & Prophecy
 - Covers Creation, the Fall, and Israel
- **New Testament = new covenant – 27 Books**
 - Gospels, Acts, Romans to Revelation

- Pastoral, Church & Christian Group letters
- From Jesus, formation of the Church, to Restoration



Life Group Questions Week of 01/25/2026 (Simplified Bible)

BIG IDEA: Understand the simplified overview of the whole Bible.

PRIMER TO READ ALOUD:

The Bible is not nearly as "deep" as the educational system and institutional religion teach it to be. The Bible is RELATIONAL. The **Word of God** is simply INSPIRATION—REVELATION—ILLUMINATION, or, more easily understood, God to People, People to Paper, Paper to Heart.

The 6 phases of God's will / story are:

1. Creation
2. The Fall
3. Israel
4. Jesus
5. The Church
6. Restoration/New Creation

Realizing the Bible is a very simple library of 66 books is the motivation needed to grow as a disciple of Jesus. Disciple is best defined as "learner!"

Read **Matthew 28:18-20** and point out where it uses the word “disciple.” Are you a disciple of God’s Word? Are you making disciples?

ICE BREAKERS

1. Please tell the “Who-What-When-Where” story regarding your first encounter with a Bible.
2. What is your favorite and not-so-favorite thing about the Bible?

ACADEMIC QUESTIONS

1. Trent drew an **image of the Bible** on the big screen this past weekend. Try to name the different parts of the image that was drawn. Repeat the best you can why it is recommended not to use Romans to Revelation to teach people how to be saved in Jesus.
2. Read the following passages and discuss how the verses personally apply to your lives. **Genesis 18:17-19, Proverbs 16:17-21, John 1:1-5, Acts 2:37-47, Matthew 6:9-15.**
3. Flip through as many of the New Testament books as you can and identify which books/letters are Historical, Pastoral, Church, or Christian Group focused
 - **4 Pastoral books:** 1 & 2 Timothy, Titus, and Philemon
 - **9 “Church” books all written by Paul:** 1 & 2 Thessalonians, Colossians, Philippians, Ephesians, Galatians, 1 & 2 Corinthians, and Romans
 - **9 Christian-Group books:** Hebrews, James, 1 & 2 Peter, 1, 2 & 3rd John, Revelation
 - **5 Historical books:** Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, and Acts

PERSONAL CONNECTION & DISCUSSION

1. Share some ideas with one another about whether or not you journal while reading God’s Word. It is said that the difference between reading and studying God’s word is simply the use of pen and paper.
2. Discuss around the circle your personal commitments to read the Bible regularly. Is there anything we can do as a group to help prod each other on?

GUIDING VERSE REFLECTION

2 Timothy 3:16-17 *“All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.” (NLT)*

Discuss: Anyone want to volunteer a response regarding to how the Scripture made you realize what is wrong in your life? How about it teaching you to do what is right in your life?

APPLICATION

American culture is actually hungry and growing in its desire for spiritual discussions. This same culture is more open to learning about God. What a time to honor the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20). Who are you encountering regularly and planning to have more spiritual discussions with?

CLOSING PRAYER

Pray for each other's prayer requests. Also: Pray for one another to grow in your understanding of the simplicity of the Bible, grow in your desire to spend more time reading and applying it to your lives, and go out into the world making disciples of people!
